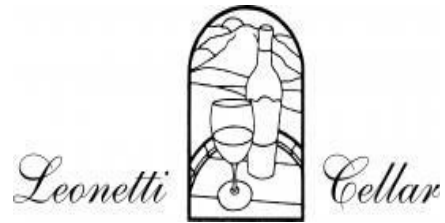

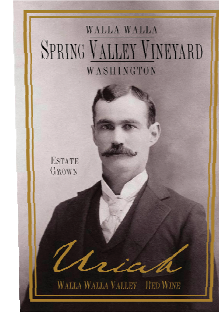

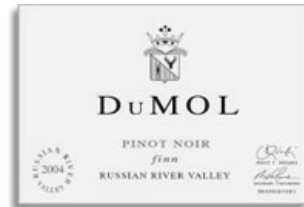

Then, in 1982, Chateau Mouton-Rothschild again became a part of history. A little known wine critic, Robert Parker Jr., declared the wine perfect and bestowed a 100 point rating. The artist label commemorating this great vintage is the actor/director John Huston.
